Introduction

It is now over 10 years since the first Orthopilot navigated knee replacements were performed in the UK. Over the years navigation has become a standard of care in many centres. The first navigated procedures worldwide were carried out by our chairmen (Mr Fred Picard and Mr Alberto Gregori) in Grenoble, France and are recognised as the international leaders in this field of Orthopaedic Surgery.

The latest updates in computer assisted surgery has introduced advanced soft tissue management options and has moved from primary knee replacement to the complex revision situations: The hip navigation provides a simplified and reproducible platform for both acetabular alignment as well as a 3D reconstruction of the joint.

This event marks the first annual Orthopilot Navigation User forum in the UK: a unique opportunity for navigators to discuss the current state of the art in navigated joint replacement as presented by the world leaders. The international faculty includes Dr David Stulberg from Chicago one of the main innovators in both knee replacement surgery and minimal invasive surgery as well as past president of CAOS International.

The major advantages of navigated surgery will be discussed with key note lectures on the Caledonia Method for reduced patient stay and minimal invasive surgery. The open forum will allow adequate time for discussion and we encourage active participation from the delegates in this debate.

The meeting is aimed at current and potential navigators and will give an insight into the current clinical applications and results in navigated surgery as well as looking at advanced aspects of patient care.
